

The setting

The Department of Intensive Care of the Erasme University Hospital is one of the largest in Europe, with 35 beds in 5 ICUs caring for 3000 patients each year. The patients represent a typical mixture of the critically ill covering all aspects of intensive care (medical, surgical, trauma, organ transplant,...). The department has a full-time medical staff and is well supported by nursing and paramedical personnel.

The format

The program is dedicated to providing representatives from the industry with exposure to major ICU problems. It combines informal seminars with visits to the ICU (including bedside demonstrations), and encourages interactive discussions with staff physicians and allied health care personnel.
