

General Terms and Conditions for Participants, Exhibitors and/or Sponsors at the International Symposium on Intensive Care and Emergency Medicine (ISICEM)

The International Symposium on Intensive care and Emergency Medicine (ISICEM) is organized by Promotion des Soins Intensifs (a non-profit association) with academic support from the Departments of Intensive Care and Emergency Medicine of Erasme University Hospital, Université Libre de Bruxelles and the Belgian Society of Intensive Care (SIZ)

I/ PARTICIPANT

These General Terms and Conditions apply to each participant registered for the 38th International Symposium on Intensive Care and Emergency Medicine, 20-23 March 2018 in Brussels, Belgium. By registering, you accept all terms and conditions contained herein.

All registrations must be made online via our website www.intensive.org.

Deadlines for registration fees

Early bird registration: until (and including) 10 January 2018 23:59 CET

2nd price period: from 11th January – 28 February 2018 (inclusive) 23:59 CET

March registration: from 1 March 2018 CET

The applicable fee will be calculated according to the date on which payment is received, not the date on which the registration form is completed. Should a deadline be missed, the next applicable fee will be charged automatically. Registration is only confirmed after receipt of payment in full.

Proof of status

For doctor ESICM members, the membership code must be provided during the registration process in order to benefit from the reduced fee.

Doctors from countries with low and lower middle gross national incomes (as defined by the World Bank Atlas method 2017 see list [here](#)) benefit from reduced registration rates - the same as those of non-doctors. This rate will be applied automatically when relevant and proof of residence/employment in the country in question must be provided.

Non-doctor participants (students, nurses, physiotherapists, and other allied healthcare professionals) must submit proof of status (e.g., business card, official letter from Head of Department,..) to the ISICEM Registration Department during the registration process.

Entitlements

The registration fee includes entrance to the full scientific program, a congress bag, and a copy of the Annual Update in Intensive Care and Emergency Medicine, 2018.

Methods of payment

Payment is required at the time of registration and will be charged in EUR. All costs are the responsibility of the payer.

Name changes will be subject to a handling fee of 65 Euros and accepted until January 11, 2018.

Visa Procedures

It is the responsibility of each participant to check their visa and passport requirements. Participants requiring a visa should apply to the Belgian Consular office or Embassy in their own country. Please note the visa application procedure can take at least two months.

An invitation letter can be directly downloaded via our website.

Please note, requests for refunds of registration fees if a visa is refused will only be considered if an official document from the embassy is sent to the ISICEM secretariat showing that the visa was applied for in time and confirming that it could not be granted.

Photography

Registration Cancellation Policy
